The fall colors remind us, that there is even beauty in change. For Sept and Oct, we have traveled over 4,250 miles by car, which doesn't include traveling to FL on the Amtrak Auto train in Sept. We've traveled for over 5 1/2 weeks sharing the ministry of Togo with different individuals and groups. We traveled to FL, AL, OH, IL (personal), MD, DC, NC, SC, TN & PA to just name a few places that we were. We have been blessed beyond measure with great hospitality and travel safety also. And we did get to enjoy the beauty of fall as we traveled in Oct. We've attached a few pictures of our times. Sorry we can't share all of them!

TOGO—the churches and schools were closed for about 4 weeks in Sept/Oct due to the Delta variant. But they've all reopened again. PTL! Also, the death rate from COVID for Togo is still less than 1%. Togo, and most W. African countries have built in factors that help them—about 60% of the population is 30 or younger; life expectancy of about 55 (so not as many elderly); tropical, outdoor living (for the most part), and many of the population received BCG immunization at birth (against TB), which seems to be helping. We are blessed to get to return to Togo for 2 weeks the middle of Nov to encourage our team there and to check on the HBB Vision Project. Thank-you for praying for us as we travel!
